# Getting to know your medicine

A simple guide to Emgality® ▼ (galcanezumab)

This leaflet is for people who have been prescribed Emgality as a treatment for migraine.



# Welcome to your new medicine

Emgality is a once monthly, self-injected, subcutaneous injection that is specifically developed to prevent migraine.

In this leaflet, you'll find important information about Emgality, such as how to take the medicine, what to do if you miss a dose and advice on storage.

For more details, please refer to the Patient Information Leaflet that came with your medicine or speak to your healthcare professional.

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# What is Emgality?

Emgality is a once-monthly injection designed to prevent migraines.



# How does your medicine work?



Migraine attacks are associated with elevated blood concentrations of Calcitonin gene-related peptides (CGRP's).



The active ingredient in Emgality is called galcanezumab which is a specially designed protein (antibody) that attaches (binds) to CGRP preventing its action.



# What is in the pack?

Emgality pen is for single use only and contains one dose of Emgality (120 mg of galcanezumab).

Month 1: Initial loading dose of 240 mg (2 x 120 mg injections) Subsequent months: One 120 mg injection per month



Take your device out of the refrigerator and leave at room temperature for 30 minutes before injecting. Do not shake. Wash your hands, select an injection site (see later) and clean with an alcohol wipe. Let the injection site dry before you inject. Another person may give you Emgality in the back of your upper arm or buttocks.



# 1. Uncap the pen. Twist off the base cap and throw it away. Do not put the base cap back on, as this could damage the needle. Do not touch the needle.



2. Place and unlock. Place and hold the clear base flat and firmly against your skin. Turn the lock ring to the unlock position.



3. Press, hold, and listen. Press and hold down the teal injection button whilst holding the clear base firmly against your skin. You will hear a loud click. 5-10 seconds later you will hear a second click. This means the injection is complete. Remove the pen from your skin.

Your box will also contain a Patient Information Leaflet with further details of your medicine.



# What you need to know before you take your medicine

# O DO NOT TAKE EMGALITY



If you are **allergic to** any of the ingredients in this medicine (For a full list, see Section 6 of the Patient Information Leaflet)



Talk to your doctor, pharmacist or nurse before or during your treatment if you have a serious **cardiovascular disease** 



This medicine should not be given to children and adolescents **under 18** years of age





# Pregnancy and breast-feeding

If you are a woman able to have children, you are advised to avoid becoming pregnant while using Emgality.

If you are pregnant, think you may be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, ask your doctor for advice before taking this medicine. It is preferable to avoid the use of Emgality in pregnancy as the effects of this medicine in pregnant women are not known.

If you are breast-feeding or are planning to breast-feed, talk to your doctor before using this medicine.

You and your doctor should decide if you should breast feed and use Emgality.



# How to take Emgality?



Select an injection Do not inject within site and clean with an alcohol wipe



5 centimeters of the belly button (navel)



Avoid injecting in the exact same spot each time you inject

# What if you miss a dose?



If you miss a dose, inject it as soon as possible and then inject the next dose after a month from that date.

If you have any questions regarding missed doses speak to a doctor.

# What to watch out for?

As with all medicines, Emgality may cause side effects, though not everybody gets them.

### **Serious Side effects**

Allergic reactions with Emgality are usually mild to moderate (such as a rash or itching). Serious allergic reactions may occur rarely (may affect up to 1 in 1,000 people) and signs may include:

- · difficulty breathing or swallowing,
- low blood pressure, which can cause dizziness or lightheadedness,
- swelling of the neck, face, mouth, lips, tongue or throat which may develop rapidly,
- severe itching of the skin, with a red rash or raised bumps.

# Very common side effects

(May affect more than 1 in 10 people)

- · Injection site pain
- Injection site reactions (e.g. red skin, itching, bruising, swelling)

## **Common side effects**

(May affect up to 1 in 10 people)

- Vertigo (a feeling of dizziness or 'spinning')
- Constipation
- Itching
- Rash

# **Uncommon Side effects**

(May affect up to 1 in 100 people)

• Hives (raised itchy areas of skin)

# How to store Emgality



**Store in the original package** in order to protect from light.



Keep this medicine out of sight and reach of children



**Store in a refrigerator between 2°C - 8°C.** This medicine can be stored un-refrigerated for up to 7 days when stored at temperatures up to 30°C. If these conditions are exceeded, the pre-filled pen must be discarded



Do not use this medicine after the expiry date that is stated on the pen and on the carton.



Once you are done injecting, simply dispose of the pen as directed by your doctor and according to local regulations
